SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

The key findings of the data analysis point towards a range of issues prevalent in Pakistani prisons which include, but are not limited to, overcrowding, significantly long under-trial periods, lack of infrastructure, problem of housing women/juveniles and inadequate medical facilities. The continuous rise in the prison population has resulted in an even lower jail capacity. Thus, the current prison situation is in dire need of reform to ensure a basic standard of living for those serving their prison sentences.















Prison Population Trend












Year 2023 Prisons Breakdown




- 28 out of 44 jails in Punjab are overcrowded.
- 72.4% of the prisoners in Punjab are still under-trial.
- 27 out of 28 overcrowded jails have more than 70% of under-trial prisoners.
- There are 2400 prisoners on death row in Punjab.
- Juveniles: 745 (out of which 78.9% are under trial)
- Women: 998 (out of which 79% are under trial)











Year 2023 Prisons Breakdown




- 15 out of 23 functional jails in Sindh are overcrowded.
- 80% of the prisoners in Sindh are still under-trial.
- 12 out of 15 overcrowded jails have 80% or more under-trial prisoners.
- There are 526 prisoners on death row in Sindh.
- Juveniles: 407 (out of which 89% are under trial)
- Women: 286 (out of which 80% are under trial)






Prison Population Trend





- Women: 160 (out of which 78% are under trial)






Under Trial Prisoners



Top Offences

Punjab



- Overall, overcrowding is 5%; however, 3 jails in Baluchistan are severely overcrowded.
- 63% of the prisoners in Baluchistan are under-trial
- There are more than 90% under-trial prisoners in 2 out of 3 overcrowded jails
- There are 396 prisoners on death row in Baluchistan
- Juveniles: 7 (out of which 4 are convicted)
- Women: 36 (out of which 20 are under trial)







- 4 out of 7 prisons in AJ&K are overcrowded.
- 59% of the prisoners in AJ&K are still under-trial.
- All overcrowded jails have more than 50% of under-trial prisoners.
- There are 391 prisoners on death row in AJ&K.
- Juveniles: 13 (all are under trial)
- Women: 12 (out of which 3 are under trial)


WOMEN PRISONERS IN 2023 PAKISTAN
















Prison Population Trend (Women Prisoners)

UNDER-TRIAL PERCENTAGE

78.1%

- There are 3 specialized women jails; i.e., 2 in Sindh, 1 in Punjab.
- 78% of women prisoners remain under trial (as of Nov, 2023).
- Compared to men, women prisoners face more difficulty accessing healthcare
- No women jails in KP and Balochistan
- Compared to male prisoners, no earning opportunities for women in Balochistan jails.
- Approx. 27% women are placed in jails away from their home districts

Data Limitations

We regret to inform our readers that data from Gilgit Baltistan is notably missing from our dataset. The absence of this region's data underscores the need for comprehensive and standardized data collection practices nationwide.
